Speaker Adams has a background in corporate training and childhood development, and first entered public service as a member of Queens Community Board 12. She has also served in leadership positions for community-based organizations and advisory committees, guiding significant funding and investments for workforce and business development, education, health and wellness, housing, and transportation for the Downtown Jamaica area.
